Violation #5 Replace or repair exit sign near elevator on floor 3. Replace stained ceiling tiles throughout facility.  
**Code Reference** FAC: Maintenance & Repair 64E-13.004(3)(b)(c). Buildings shall be kept clean and in good repair, free from hazardous conditions, such as loose or broken floor tiles and boards; loose moldings; loose hanging fixtures, pipes, and electric wires; and broken plaster. Furnishings and equipment shall be kept clean and in good repair, free of missing parts and hazards such as sharp edges, splinters, and protruding or rusty nails.

Violation #19 Replace or repair broken handle on water fountain near 100D stairwell on floor 2.  
**Code Reference** FAC: Drinking Fountains 64E-13.004(7)(b). Drinking fountains of an approved, sanitary slant jet type shall be provided in the ratio specified in the local building code or Chapter 64E-10, F.A.C. In no case shall fountains be located in any toilet room.

Violation #23 Eliminate spider webs through recreational areas of building.  
**Code Reference** FAC: Infestation/Control 64E-13.004(10). Effective measures shall be used to prevent harborage, propagation, or infestations of rodents and all insects.
