**VISUAL ARTS CLASS**

- **1 hardcover sketchbook, spiral bound**, at least 100 pages, 80 pound quality drawing paper, approximate size, 9X12 inches; paper should be heavy enough for both wet and dry media. It should be portable to be carried from and to school (suggested locations to purchase sketchbooks: Jerry's Artarama (SW 8<sup>th</sup> Street & 67<sup>th</sup> Ave), Utrecht, Michaels', and Dick Blick Art Supplies.
- 1 large box of baby wipes (not travel-size).
- 1 drawing pencil set (includes 2B, 4B, 6B, 2 regular HB graphite pencils, 2 charcoal pencils) (Prismacolor, Prang, Design, Derwent and Faver-Castell are all good brands).
- 1 regular eraser (Magic Rub white eraser preferably).
- 1 roll of paper towel and/or 100 paper/plastic plates\*.
- 1 set of colored pencils (any brand)\*.
- Several ultra-fine point permanent black markers (Sharpies) \*.
- Several fine-point permanent black markers (Sharpies) \*.
- 1 color set of student's favorite combination of ultra-fine colored sharpies\*\*.
- 1 color set of fine-point colored markers (Sharpies) \*\*.
